#### **Koichi Aiboshi (Japan)**

Mr. Koichi Aiboshi is Deputy Director-General for International Cooperation and Global Issues at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Japan. He serves as a negotiator for finance in the climate change negotiations and as an expert on development in the G8 and the G20 processes. Prior to being appointed as Deputy Director-General, Mr. Aiboshi occupied various positions, including Deputy Assistant Vice-Minister for Parliamentary Affairs in Japan, Deputy Chief of Mission of the Embassy of Japan in Vietnam, Minister for political affairs at the Embassy of Japan in the Republic of Korea, and Director of the Loan Aid Division, of the Second Middle East Division and of the Humanitarian Assistance Division in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan. Mr. Aiboshi entered the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1983 and, from 1991 to 1996, served as Deputy Director in the First Southeast Asia Division of the Asian Affairs Bureau and in the First International Economic Affairs Division of the Economic Affairs Bureau. He was then appointed as First Secretary of the Embassy of Japan in France and in the Republic of Korea before serving as Counselor of the Embassy of Japan in the Republic of Korea.
